

Call for Papers: World History Association 12th Annual Conference June 26-29 2003

Interested teachers and scholars are invited to submit proposals for papers and/or panels to be presented at the twelfth annual meeting of the World History Association, June 26-29 2003, at Georgia State University, Atlanta, Georgia. Papers on the scholarly and/or pedagogical aspects of the following themes are especially encouraged, but proposals outside these themes will also be considered.

The primary themes are:

1) Migration and Identity; 2) Comparative Perspectives on Islam and Islamic Politics; 3) The Boundaries of World History: Chronological, Methodological, Disciplinary.

Proposals for individual papers or entire panels should include the following information: The title of paper or panel; a brief description of the content and approach of each paper (and the focus of the panel); the name and institutional affiliation of the participant; whether the participant is a current member of the WHA.
