AP® World History

Presenter: Joseph P. “Jay” Harmon has been a high school history teacher for 26 years. He currently teaches AP World History and world history at Cypress Woods High School in Cypress, Texas. From 1986 to 2006, he served on the faculty of Catholic High School in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, where he initiated the honors and AP programs and was chair of the Social Studies Department for 17 years. He taught AP World History, AP U.S. History, and AP European History as well as honors history courses.

Harmon is currently a member of the AP World History Development Committee and has also served as an AP Exam Reader, AP World History Exam Question Leader, Table Leader, and AP workshop and Summer Institute presenter. He has also presented at U.S. and international conferences including several AP Annual Conferences and the First European Congress of World and Global History.

Harmon is the author of *U.S. History Flashcards Flip-O-Matic* and *World Civilizations: The Global Experience, 4th AP Edition*. His many recognitions and awards include being named in the Who's Who Among America's High School Teachers in 2004, and being named Louisiana Teacher of the Year and Baton Rouge Teacher of the Year in 1997. The same year, the mayor of Baton Rouge proclaimed a Jay Harmon Day.

Harmon holds a Bachelor of Science in Secondary Social Studies Education and a Master of Education in Education Administration from Louisiana State University.
